Operational Summary

October 7, 2023, an intense armed conflict erupted between Israel and Hamas-led Palestinian militant groups, centered mainly in the Gaza Strip. The conflict began with a large-scale assault by Hamas, resulting in significant casualties and extensive damage. In response, Israel launched a series of military operations targeting Hamas infrastructure and positions within Gaza.

The violence has not been confined to Gaza alone. Clashes spread to the Israeli-occupied West Bank, where tensions have escalated between Israeli forces and Palestinian residents. Additionally, the conflict has extended to Israel's northern borders with Lebanon and Syria, where Hezbollah, a militant group backed by Iran, has engaged in hostilities against Israeli positions.

The situation resulted in a severe humanitarian crisis, with thousands of casualties, widespread destruction, and displacement of civilians. International efforts for a ceasefire have been ongoing, but a resolution remains elusive as both sides continue to engage in hostilities, further complicating the regional stability and exacerbating the humanitarian impact.

For four weeks, HARP dedicated its efforts to rescuing and evacuating American citizens (AMCITS) from Israel and Gaza, ensuring their safe passage to neighboring countries that could better facilitate their safety and needs. Throughout this period, HARP not only managed the logistics of evacuation but also provided critical security and secure communication services for those at risk.

Their operations included coordinating with local and international agencies to establish safe routes out of conflict zones, often navigating through hostile environments and ensuring that evacuees received necessary aid upon arrival. HARP's team worked tirelessly to maintain

secure lines of communication, enabling evacuees to stay in contact with their families and receive real-time updates about the evolving situation.

Additionally, HARP's security teams protected evacuees from potential threats, offering a layer of safety amid the chaos. This comprehensive approach ensured that those fleeing the conflict could do so with a greater sense of security and stability. The mission's success was a testament to HARP's commitment and capability in providing life-saving assistance in some of the most challenging and dangerous conditions.
