## Methods:

The Oregon Trail fire posed an imminent threat to lives, properties, and the overall well-being of the affected communities. In the face of this dire situation, HARP responded swiftly, mobilizing resources, expertise, and unwavering determination to fulfill three primary objectives:

- 1. **Evacuation:** HARP played a pivotal role in coordinating and executing safe and efficient evacuations. Our team collaborated seamlessly with local authorities to ensure the swift and secure relocation of residents from harm's way, with an unwavering commitment to prioritizing their safety above all else.
- 2. Aid: Recognizing the immediate need for relief and assistance for those impacted by the fire, HARP enlisted the support of Global Empowerment Mission (GEM), an organization renowned for its rapid execution of critical aid efforts. Through this collaborative effort, HARP and GEM swiftly distributed over \$250,000 worth of crucial aid supplies to those rendered homeless. Furthermore, over \$25,000 in monetary aid was also distributed by BStrong (a GEM partner) to individuals and families facing unimaginable adversity.
- 3. **Route Closures:** To contain the rapidly spreading blaze and minimize further destruction, our team of experts worked diligently to establish and manage strategic route closures. This proactive measure proved vital in safeguarding communities and enabling emergency response teams to operate effectively.
