### **Operational Summary**

HARP was deployed to the state of Arizona to assist the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and local authorities in identifying and dismantling cartel trafficking routes used to smuggle women, children, and drugs into the United States. The operation uncovered sophisticated underground passageways equipped with advanced technologies such as fiber optic communications and ground sensors, designed to evade detection. By monitoring these trafficking corridors, HARP was able to locate several previously unknown routes, significantly disrupting the operations of trafficking networks in the region. The detailed intelligence gathered during the mission not only helped in intercepting ongoing smuggling activities but also provided critical insights into the methods and technologies employed by traffickers, aiding in the development of more effective countermeasures for future enforcement efforts.
