In 2015, HARP undertook a mission to South Sudan, collaborating with another NGO to locate and remove anti-personnel and anti-tank mines left over from the wars that had ravaged the country a decade earlier. This dangerous task aimed to make the outskirts of South Sudan safer for the local population. In addition to demining efforts, HARP provided critical assistance to several local communities by distributing food, water, and medicine. They also offered financial support, which facilitated long-term education for 13 children in these communities. Through these efforts, HARP not only addressed immediate needs but also contributed to the ongoing development and stability of the region.
