Hurricane Dorian is one of the most catastrophic natural disasters to strike The Bahamas. The impact of this destructive force resulted in estimated damages and losses, reaching an alarming US\$3.4 billion (IDB, 2019), an astounding figure amounting to approximately a quarter of the country's GDP. The immense devastation caused by Hurricane Dorian underscored the urgent need for comprehensive recovery efforts.

Introduction:

On August 30th, 2019, the Humanitarian Aid and Rescue Project (HARP) embarked on a mission to the Bahamas with the primary objective of rescuing civilians who were stranded and trapped on the island of Abaco. Recognizing the urgent need for immediate assistance, HARP mobilized its resources and deployed a dedicated team to conduct search and rescue operations in the affected areas.

Requests:

HARP received a multitude of appeals for assistance from respected NGOs, fire departments, and law enforcement agencies, all requesting their support in extracting civilians who were trapped and in imminent danger on the island of Abaco. In addition to restoring electricity, HARP demonstrated its resourcefulness by constructing and implementing a desalination system. This innovative solution effectively converted ocean water into clean, fresh, and purified water, ensuring access to safe water and sanitation for the hospital and contributing significantly to the well-being and recovery of the affected population.

Furthermore, in collaboration with their valuable partner GoTenna, HARP provided a wireless mesh communications platform. This advanced technology enabled doctors to communicate effectively with each other and those on the mainland, facilitating coordinated efforts to save lives and provide critical medical assistance.

HARP's swift actions, comprehensive resource restoration initiatives, and strategic partnerships truly embody their unwavering commitment to addressing the immediate needs and promoting the overall well-being and recovery of the hurricane-devastated community.
